

The Misty Glen Board has decided to modify the language regarding “Temporary Basketball Goals” to closer align with the guidelines for permanent basketball goals. The guidance regarding Permanent Basketball Goals remains unchanged.

Section NN.5 on Page 58 is changed to read:

5. Temporary Basketball Goals

- a) Backboard must be constructed of clear fiberglass or acrylic, not plywood or particle board and shall not exceed fifty four (54) inches in width with a maximum offset of two feet (2’).
- b) Goal, net and safety padding for poles (if used) must be maintained in good condition.
- c) Temporary goals must be of type that can be folded (collapsed) and lowered each night and when not in use.
- d) Goals must be located on side of driveway and not where the play area is in the street.
